Dear Clint ISD Early College Academy Families,

Due to the recent spike in COVID-19 diagnoses and the 15% hospitalization rate, the Clint district has received approval from the Texas Education Agency for a waiver to postpone in-school instruction and resume at-home instruction. The Clint ISD Early College Academy will suspend in-person instruction for our students, and teachers will begin remote teaching on October 12, 2020. We will follow the same plan we had for remote instruction before returning on October 5, 2020. October 26, 2020, is the earliest date for students to return to the school for in-person instruction.

The Clint district made the decision to keep students and staff safe during the increased diagnoses of the COVID-19 virus. I am pleading with families and staff to practice rigorous health and safety routines to avoid contracting the virus. Although we have implemented strict health and safety measures at CECA with fidelity, the rapidly increasing number of infections is concerning. We had to act in the best interest of students, families, and staff.

To summarize this message, students will not return to the CECA campus on October 12, 2020. All students will learn via remote instruction using the at-home schedule we started in the first nine-week grading period. The earliest that students can return to the school is October 26, 2020. Please stay updated on changes in the CECA plan.
