## Clint Early College Academy (CECA) Design Elements Implementation

Bridge Programs CECA offers a comprehensive summer bridge program designed to prepare incoming freshmen for the academic rigor of early college coursework. This program includes study skills workshops, introductory college-level coursework, and orientation sessions to familiarize students with campus resources. In Spring of 2025 we will host a one day Spring Bridge to allow prospective students to see CECA in action and the day in the life of a CECA student.

Advising Students at CECA receive personalized academic advising through a structured support system. The CECA counselor provides guidance on course selection, college degree pathways, and transferability of credits. Regular check-ins ensure students remain on track to meet their academic and career goals.

Student Intervention CECA implements proactive student intervention strategies, including academic progress monitoring, tutoring services, and mentorship programs. Intervention teams analyze student performance data to identify those at risk and implement targeted support plans to ensure student success.

Classroom Supports CECA integrates evidence-based instructional strategies to support diverse learners. Faculty provide differentiated instruction, embedded tutoring within college courses, and access to supplemental learning resources to reinforce student comprehension and engagement.

Wrap-Around Strategies and Services CECA offers holistic student support services, including socialemotional learning programs, mental health counseling, and family engagement initiatives. Partnerships with community organizations provide additional resources such as food assistance and transportation support when needed.

Enrichment Opportunities To foster a well-rounded educational experience, CECA provides enrichment programs such as academic clubs, leadership development workshops, and experiential learning opportunities. Students participate in research projects, internships, and service-learning activities to enhance their skills beyond the classroom.

College and Career Preparation CECA equips students with essential college and career readiness skills through dual credit courses, career exploration workshops, and financial aid literacy programs. Students engage in job shadowing experiences, resume-building sessions, and university visits to prepare for postsecondary education and professional pathways.
